Art 1 Basic Design Ms. Carter Kaleidoscope Name Project

- 1. Fold the paper twice so that you have four quadrants or sections.
- 2. In ONE section, draw your name in bubble letters or a graffiti font. The letters should overlap in places and touch or go off the edge of the page.
- 3. Draw darkly over the outline of each letter (using an ebony pencil if available) and transfer them onto the next section by folding the paper over. Scrape over the paper with a straight edge (ruler, side of a pencil) until the pencil lines come off onto the other side.
- 4. If the lines are not dark enough to see yet, keep adding pencil lead to the first section, folding the page over again, and scraping over the pencil. When you get enough of an outline of the letters that you can see, draw over them with your pencil.
- 5. Do this for each of the other 3 sections.
- 6. Grab some colored pencils and color in your kaleidoscope name. Each letter should be the same color in each section and overlapping letter should be different colors. Basically, wherever you hit a line when coloring you should stop and use a different color.
- 7. Make it interesting. These are just guidelines so take your time and be creative!
